Holyrood Park

The Park was first established in the 1100s as a royal hunting ground. The Park contains archaeological remains and geological features that are of national and international importance. Many rare species and habitats also contribute to making the Park unique.

	<p>Arthur's Seat – Edinburgh's Volcano Edinburgh owes its existence to a volcanic past. Arthur's Seat is the remains of a 350 million-year-old volcano. Edinburgh Castle is built on another vent of the same volcano.</p>		<p>Hunter's Bog Hunter's Bog is a haven for wildlife. It is home to the Adder's-tongue Fern, a small plant that is locally rare. This is only one of many rare plants found in the Park.</p>
	<p>The Radical Road This steep footpath was constructed by unemployed weavers during an early job creation scheme in the 1820s. They were called radicals because of their strong political views.</p>		<p>St Anthony's Chapel St Anthony's Chapel was built in the late medieval period, some time after King David divided the Park between the abbeys of Holyrood and Kelso. The Chapel and the adjacent well were places of pilgrimage for people with skin problems.</p>
	<p>Dunsapie Crag Dunsapie Crag is one of four Iron Age forts here. The whole Park has been designated a Scheduled Ancient Monument to protect important archaeological remains.</p>		<p>Duddingston Loch The Loch and surrounding woodland form a bird sanctuary. The entire Park has been designated a Site of Special Scientific Interest, a national designation given to protect specific examples of wildlife.</p>

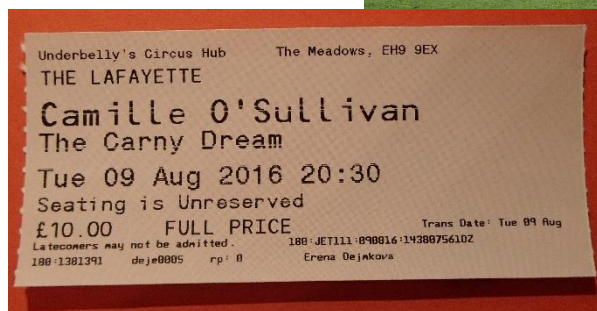
